About YFU Namibia

Youth for Understanding (YFU) is one of the world's oldest and largest youth exchange and study abroad organizations and has been trusted to provide cultural exchange opportunities for more than 270,000 high school learners since 1951.

The initial purpose of YFU was to bring young post-second world war German youth to the United States to experience democracy by living with American host families and attend high school for one year. The idea spread from there, and today YFU is one of the largest and most respected international exchange organizations in the world.

YFU is a non-profit, volunteer-driven organization with offices in 50+ countries. In South Africa, YFU opened its doors in Cape Town in 1994, and received the first group of exchange students from Germany in 1995. Since then, YFU South Africa has received and sent hundreds of high school learners on our intercultural study abroad programmes to Europe, Latin America and other parts of the world. Our Namibian branch was launched in 2023 and we sent our first Namibian student abroad in 2024.

YFU's mission is to advance intercultural understanding, life-long learning, global competencies, mutual respect, and social responsibility through transformational educational exchanges for generations of youth, families, and communities.

How Our Programmes Work



YFU high school study abroad participants can choose from over 20 different destinations in Europe and Latin America. Our most popular countries include Germany, Belgium, France, Austria, Switzerland, Chile and Argentina, but we also offer programmes to more 'exotic' countries such as Estonia, Paraguay, Slovakia and many others.



YFU's philosophy is that one only manages to fully integrate into a new culture over a period of one year. Therefore, we regard the 1-year programme as our 'Golden Standard'. However, we also offer shorter study abroad experiences, namely for a semester (5 months), a trimester (2-4 months) and short exchanges of 4-8 weeks.



All our programmes are educational, homestay experiences. This means that YFU students are placed with a carefully-selected local host family for the duration of their exchange. YFU host families come in all shapes and sizes and represent the culture and diversity of the host country. YFU students are not guests - they truly become a part of their host family and often build life-long relationships.



Except for some of our short 'holiday programmes' all YFU students attend a local high school in their host country. This means that they have a unique opportunity to experience a different educational system, learn the local language through full immersion, and explore different subjects and a different style of teaching.



Besides the usual high school programme, certain YFU partner countries offer programmes with specialization in sports, visual arts, film/movies, fashion, tourism, nature, catering, archaeology, music, drama and dance. Through our educational study abroad programmes, YFU students acquire a passion for life-long learning, as well as the skills and knowledge to thrive and contribute to cultural diversity. You will learn an additional foreign language or have the opportunity to perfect your communication skills in a language you have been learning for some time. By immersing yourself into a different culture and experiencing life in your host country from the inside out, you will acquire the intercultural skills that will open doors for further study and international career opportunities.

How to Apply

You can apply to participate in the YFU programme if you:

- Are a registered high school learner or recent matriculant
- Are between 15 and 18 years old (at the time of the programme start date)
- Are achieving an academic performance of at least 60 % (grade C)
- Are independent, mature, curious, open-minded and adaptable
- Are willing to reach out to people of a different background than your own
- Have your parents' and school's support and approval to apply
- Are eager to learn about a new culture and to share your own culture
- Understand that the YFU programme is not a holiday and that you will be required to fully participate in school, family life and everyday activities and chores
- Are willing to learn a new language or to perfect your foreign language skills
- Would like to stay involved in YFU after your exchange.

Do I need to speak the local language of my host country?

No, most of our partner countries (except France) do not require prior knowledge of the local language. However, an intensive language course before you go abroad will assist you to quickly adapt to your new life with your host family and at school!

Does my family have to host an exchange learner while I go abroad?

No, this is not a requirement for participation. However, we encourage the families of YFU programme participants to consider hosting as a way of giving back, and making it possible for a learner from another country to experience Namibia.

How to apply?

The first step is to download and complete the pre-application form ([available here](#)) and email it to Lena@yfu.org.za, together with the following additional documents:

- A copy of your ID or passport
- Your most recent term report
- Your full academic report for last year
- A head and shoulder picture of yourself.

Once we have received these documents, we will arrange a personal meeting with you and your parents and guide you through the next steps in the process!



Programme Fees

YFU is a not for profit organisation. All programme fees are used to cover the costs of providing programmes in Namibia and in our partner countries. While the breakdown of costs varies slightly depending on the host country and the length of the study abroad programme, the average breakdown of costs is:

- 30% for international travel and insurance (medical, travel and liability)
- 60% for the placement and support of students in the host country
- 10% for the selection and preparation of students in Namibia.

Typical Fee Structure

- 1-year high school programmes: NAD 95,000 – NAD 230,000
- Semester programmes (5 months): NAD 90,000 – NAD 190,000
- Trimester programmes (2-4 months): NAD 90,000 – NAD 140,000
- Short programmes (3-8 weeks): NAD 85,000 – NAD 130,000

What is included:

- Selection and preparation
- International travel
- Travel & medical insurance
- Placement with a carefully screened and selected volunteer host family
- Enrollment in a local high school
- Pre-departure preparation orientation in Namibia or online
- Post-arrival, mid-term and re-entry orientations in the host country
- Personal YFU contact person
- 24h emergency support
- General administrative support
- Assistance with the visa application

What is not included:

- Your personal spending money
- Visa application costs
- Passport application fee if you do not have a valid passport
- Excess luggage fees (if required)
- Domestic travel to and from closest international airport of departure from Namibia
- School books, school transport and other educational materials
- Excursions, school trips or holidays during your exchange

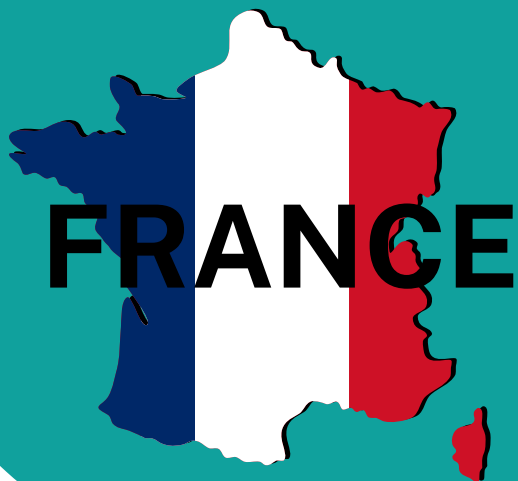
